Task 2: Digging deeper - preparing for assessment

The answers you develop to the questions in each of the tables below should give you some key points to use in the exam - and this will be particularly useful for the higher mark AO2 question which will require analysis of specific examples from the films together with accurate knowledge and understanding of film language

Representation: what are the similarities in the representations of gender / age / ethnicity between the films studied? What are the differences in the representations of gender / age / ethnicity between the films studied?

Challenge - can you identify social / cultural reasons why the representations have or haven't changed between films from different time periods?

Contexts: what are the similarities in social / cultural / political contexts between the films studied? What are the differences in social / cultural / political contexts between the films studied?

Challenge - can you identify political / historical reasons why the social / cultural / political contexts have or haven't changed between films from different time periods?

Narrative: what are the similarities in narrative structure and character roles between the films studied? What are the differences in narrative structure and character roles between the films studied?

Challenge - can you link the similarities or differences in character roles to social / cultural contexts?
